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- Create and pass Enabling Act with 3 year deadline for completion.
- Create Regional Supervisory Boards
- Create consensus in universally accepted components.
- Create regionally acceptable variations
- Create statewide funding mechanisms that remove the obligation for funding via local revenue (fees/local appropriations)


